- There is no public social/emergency housing stock

DECENT WORK AND TRAINING

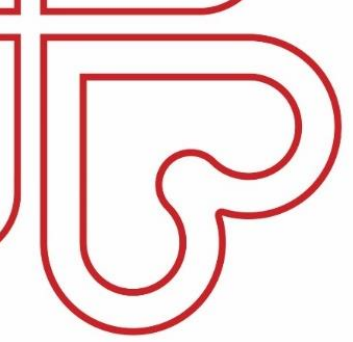
- There is no focus on employment policies for homeless people.

- There are no socio-health street units for mental health + coordination (social-health, local, regional).

SOCIAL PROTECTION

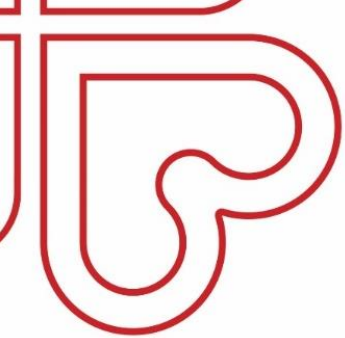
- There is no development by social services of the right to social protection, their action remaining in the organization of the distribution of economic benefits.
