### ADEQUATE HOUSING

• There is no public social/emergency housing stock

#### **DECENT WORK AND TRAINING**

• There is no focus on employment policies for homeless people.

#### **HEALTH**

• There are no socio-health street units for mental health + coordination (social-health, local, regional).

#### **SOCIAL PROTECTION**

• There is no development by social services of the right to social protection, their action remaining in the organization of the distribution of economic benefits.






