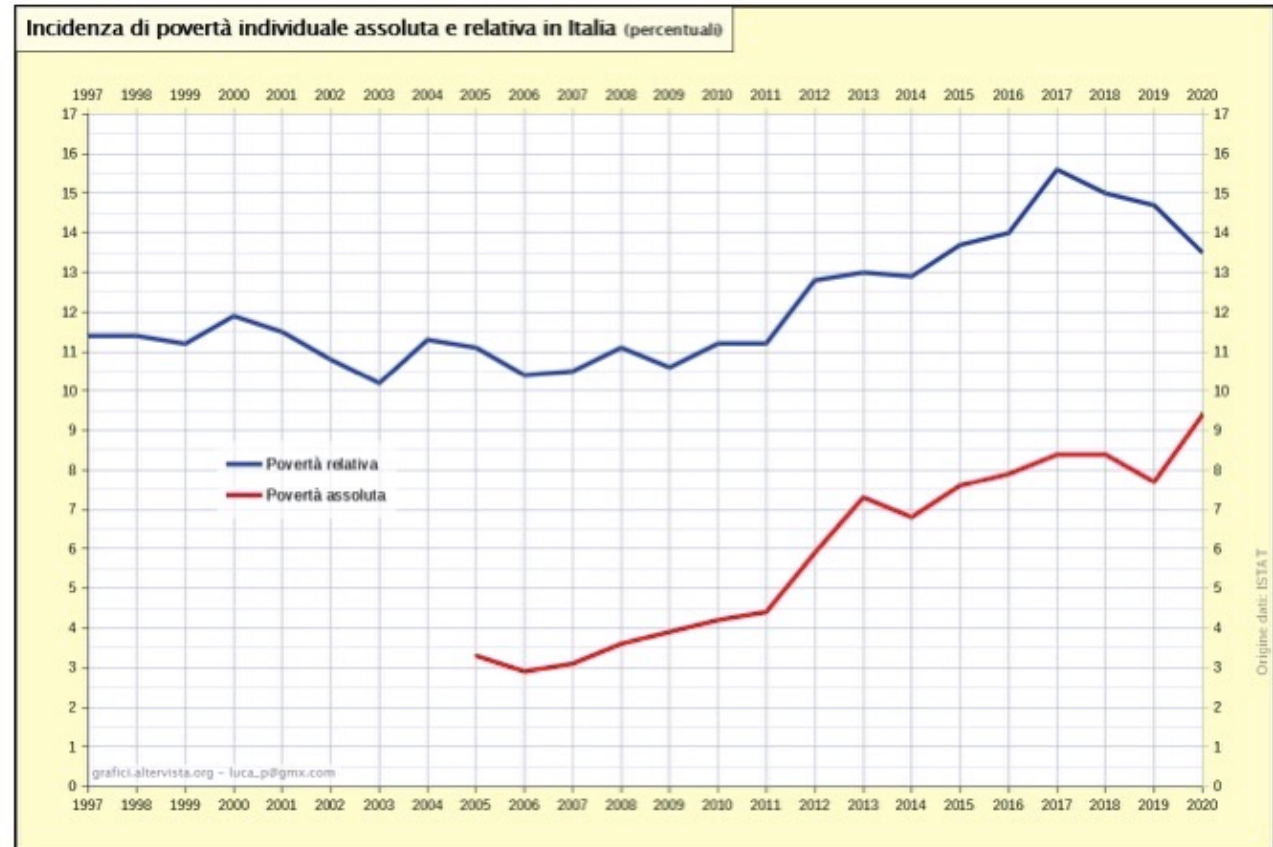

ISTAT and CARITAS

- In 2014 it was estimated that **50,724 homeless persons** used at least one soup kitchen or night shelter in the **158 italian municipalities**
- the survey was carried out in the months of November / December of that year
 - 2.43 per thousand of the population
- In 2019 annual Caritas Report register a high increase of people seeking support and the COVID tragically worsen the condition of poor people.
- 5% of people live in condition of housing severe deprivation
- Increase of absolute poverty
